



The goals are safety and practicality.





The Exterior: Steps and Walker Steps

- Steps can be individual (a stoop) or a set of steps leading to an entryway.
- Walker steps are modified to have deep treads and short risers.

The Exterior: Ramps







Permanent Ramp

Temporary Ramp

Threshold Ramp

- Ideal for limited space
- Must be installed by professional



The Exterior: Lighting and Address Numbers


- Outdoor lighting

The Kitchen: Rethinking Your Current Space


- Sit at the table to prepare food

- Drawers for maximizing space








The Bathroom: Low-Cost Safety Devices

- Transfer bench




The Bathroom: Grab or Assist Bars




